To subscribe to a CD or mount it into a virtual disk program. The process of manually installing the game in a modern system is quite involved. If you are not comfortable with using technical tools and want to be up and running easily check out the Tiberian sun installer instead. Firestorm complements Tiberian Sun with new missions, new maps, new units, and usually more fun. Many changes include not only new units, but also a rebalancing of existing ones. Artillery used by NOD, for example, has been mitigated, making it less effective, and the advantage is further diminished by the addition of Juggernaut, a multi-turret monster now available to the GDI. A team of juggernauts is invaluable in both attack and defense for GDI players. In multiplayer games, NOD will be taken equally to Cyborg Reaper, a four-legged that launches anti-infantry nets and multiple missiles. However, the biggest wildcard in the NOD strategy will probably be the mobile stealth generator (which works just as you'd expect). Both sides have been given mobile war factories, as well as limpet mines, which are connected to enemy vehicles, theoretically allowing you to see the enemy base once the vehicle returns there - similar to StarCraft's parasite. These units sound great, but their true usefulness is questionable. A mobile EMP allows GDI more flexibility in mitigating a NOD attack. Veteran units are also more useful to keep this time. They can achieve full veteran status relatively quickly, and the greater skill shown by veterans is noticeable. This feature also means that it might be worth retreating and repairing veteran units rather than building a new army. Tiberium is also much more deadly this time, with mutant plants and vicious bio-engineered life forms running amok. The spread of these life forms is central to many of Firestorm's 18 new single player missions each in GDI and NOD campaigns that get the story after winning GDI at the end of the Tiberian Sun. The missions, once again a mixture of production and non-production scenarios, are consistent in quality with those of Tiberian Sun. FMV update vids spruced in between missions push the story forward as in the original. Firestorm is doing a solid job of getting the Tiberian Sun story, and those who really enjoy the Tiberian Sun campaigns can probably expect to get several hours of enjoyment from Firestorm. Tiberian Sun was really a bit snobby. For non-strategy fans or those who are new to the wonderful world of PC games it was but for the legions of Westwood fans brought up on an addictive diet of Dune 2, Tiberian Sun wasn't quite the fix we were hoping for. It will come as no surprise to you then that, although like us, you fell asleep on the keyboard playing the game, there isn't really much in Firestorm to keep your eyelids from tightening shut while playing a little longer. As is standard with add-ons, you'll find a clutch of new units, new campaigns for each side and a few gameplay enhancements, most of which do more to expand the attractiveness of the game than you'd expect. True to form, Westwood has managed to create a quality expansion - not in terms of the game, but in presentation. Instead of grouping together a loose collection of missions and linking them to text messages or poorly delivered speech, Westwood has at least parted them with the usual big-bucks high-production video sequences, which for shipping packages is pretty much unheard of. Beyond that, the missions themselves are, for the most part, assumptions, with the usual mix of mass attack and base building from scratch. The new units, seven in total, add flavor to the bland processes and, although small in number, require a review of the overall strategy - in multiplayer games specifically. Some might find the balance of off-killer units, but overall Westwood has created a pretty good mission package for an average game. Those who loved Tiberian Sun really should get Firestorm - half the content that almost doubles the fun. Those of you who loved the first C&C&C games should wait for Renegade. Spacers.
